


### MIND YOUR MANNERS WHEN IN KYOTO...

- Shhh...** Be considerate. Move quietly when exploring residential areas or religious sites.
- Don't follow the crowd.**
- Leave your luggage behind.** Hands Free KYOTO
- Don't litter.**
- Don't block the road.**
- No smoking on public streets.**

Acts marked with a prohibition sign (🚫) may violate Japanese law. Depending on the situation, police may intervene.


Travel Smart


Enjoy hands-free sightseeing in Kyoto
